- There was discussion on the art program. Currently the Adult Art Program is every Tuesday from 10-12pm. The current \$5.00 fee to cover supplies was discussed and is covering expenses. This keeps the fee modest and allows all interested parties to come to the class and keeps the class selfsustaining.

 - a. Summer Teen Improv Program and Movies in the Park. Recommendation is to proceed with the planning of these 2 events.
 - b. Extreme Volleyball Program. More information is required before any decisions can be made.
- 9. Treasurer is requesting the 2018 budget for the Recreation Commission.
- 10. Moving forward, the monthly meetings will continue to be held at the Field House instead of Borough Hall.
