

Plastics recycling is an important part of New Jersey's recycling success story. Nearly 113,000 tons of plastic containers generated by New Jersey residences, businesses and institutions were recycled and turned into new products in 2020. The commingled plastic containers and other recyclable materials collected in New Jersey recycling programs are sorted at recycling processing centers and then sent to domestic and international end markets. While recycling market prices fluctuate just as they do with other commodities, recycled PET plastic bottles (e.g. water and soda bottles) are currently valued at \$255 per ton. Recycled HDPE Natural plastic bottles (e.g. milk jugs) are valued at \$650 per ton. Learn more about recycling at recycle.nj.gov.
